Dr. Imotemsu Ao, Director-cum-Registrar & First Appellate Authority, The Global Open University Nagaland, did not appear for the hearing.

FACTS OF THE CASE

The Commission had, on 27.10.2016 heard the appeal case in the presence of the Dr. Imotemsu Ao, Director-cum-Registrar & First Appellate Authority and Shri. Keluozie Kesiezie, Assistant Administrative Officer & PIO, The Global Open University Nagaland and decided that Shri. Keluozie Kesiezie, Assistant Administrative Officer & PIO, The Global Open University Nagaland shall submit to this Commission the date of the receipt of the RTI application dated **12.11.2015** within **1 (one) month** from the date of issue of this decision.

On receipt of the Commission's decision of even No. dated 24.11.2016, Shri. Keluozie Kesiezie, Assistant Administrative Officer & PIO, The Global Open University Nagaland had, vide letter No. GOUN/2-14/16/B/380 dated 30.11.2016 submitted compliance to this Commission.

The applicant (now appellant) had vide letter dated 20.10.2016 submitted satisfaction of information furnished to him, however, in order to ascertain the delay in furnishing the information to the applicant (now appellant), the Commission had decided to hear the case again on 22nd September (Friday), 2017 at 11:30 A.M in the Hearing Room of Nagaland Information Commission, Below Raj Bhavan, Officers' Hill Colony, Nagaland, Kohima.

OBSERVATIONS AND FINDINGS

Shri. Keluozie Kesiezie, Assistant Administrative Officer & PIO had, earlier vide letter No. GOUN/2-14/16/B/380 dated 30.11.2016 submitted to this Commission that the RTI application was received by the Public Authority on **14.01.2016**, however, on examining the Receipt Register brought by him during the hearing, it was observed that the Public Authority had actually received the RTI application on **26.11.2015**.

Further, during the hearing, Shri. Keluozie Kesiezie, Assistant Administrative Officer & PIO submitted that the RTI application was initially received by Shri. Mhonchumo on **26.11.2015** who later handed over the RTI application to Smti. Ruth, the then Assistant Administrative Officer & PIO of Dimapur Campus on **14.01.2016**. On receipt of the RTI application, Smti. Ruth, the then Assistant Administrative Officer & PIO of Dimapur Campus started processing the file during which the Kohima campus was shifted to Dimapur and as a result, Shri. Keluozie Kesiezie, the present Assistant Administrative Officer & PIO, who also got shifted to Dimapur from Kohima Campus received the file containing the RTI after application on **01.03.2016** as evidenced on the file noting produced during the hearing and furnished the information on **25.03.2016**.

The Commission had observed that the information was furnished only on **25.03.2016** i.e. after **120 days** from the date of receipt of the RTI application on **26.11.2015**. After scrutinizing and cross examining the various records produced during the hearing, the Commission had concluded that Shri. Mhonchumo, Smti. Ruth, the then Assistant Administrative Officer & PIO of Dimapur Campus and Shri. Keluozie Kesiezie, Assistant Administrative Officer & PIO had contributed to the delay in furnishing the information to the applicant (now appellant), as shown in the table below.

However, excluding the **30 days** for the PIO to furnish the information, there was a delay of **90 days**. The Commission had worked out the delay contributed by each of the three '**deemed PIOs**' for 91 days as shown below:

1. Shri. Mhonchumo contributed to the delay by **37 days**.
2. Smti. Ruth, AAO & PIO, Dimapur Campus contributed to the delay by **35 days**.
3. Shri. Keluozie Kesiezie AAO & PIO contributed to the delay by **18 days**.

DECISION

On the above observations and findings, the Commission decided to close the appeal case since the applicant (now appellant) had submitted satisfaction with the information so received. However, under section 20(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, a penalty for the delay of **90 days @ ` 250.00** per day amounting to ` 22500.00/- (Rupees twenty two thousand seven hundred and fifty only) is

imposed on the three ‘**deemed PIOs**’ for contributing to the delay in furnishing to information to the applicant (appellant).

The details of the break-up is as follows: Shri. Mhonchumo contributing to the delay by **37 days** @ ` 250.00 amounting to `**9250.00**, Smti. Ruth, AAO & PIO, Dimapur Campus contributing to the delay by **35 days** @ ` 250.00 amounting to `**8750.00** and Shri. Keluozie Kesiezie AAO & PIO contributing to the delay by **18 days** ` 250.00 amounting to `**4500.00**.

The penalty amount shall be paid within **one (1) month** from the date of receipt of this decision. The penalty amount shall be deposited in the Government account through **treasury challan** in favour of the Consultant (Accounts), Nagaland Information Commission, Kohima under the Head of Accounts given below, with a copy to this Commission:
