Sub: Closing Order of Appeal Case.

WHEREAS, under Section 19 of the RTI Act, 2005 and in accordance to the Nagaland Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2005, the Commission had received a second appeal dated 22.10.2019 from Shri. E. Victor Jami, H.No.GB/16, Midland Colony, Wokha-797111, Nagaland, Mobile No.8575698839 stating that he had not received any response to his first appeal dated 19.07.2019 which was submitted to the First Appellate Authority, Nagaland Rural Bank, Kohima against the non-response of the Public Information Officer, Nagaland Rural Bank, Head Office, Kohima-797001 to his RTI application dated 12.03.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the applicant, Shri. E. Victor Jami, had earlier submitted an RTI application vide letter dated 12.03.2019 addressed to the PIO, Nagaland Rural Bank, Head Office, Kohima along with an application fee of ₹10/- vide Banker Cheque No. Ch.264555 seeking the following information:-

*Kindly furnish Enquiry-cum-Finding Report dated 03.09.2018 at the earliest to enable me to made an appeal against my Dismissal Order dated 07.02.2019.*

AND WHEREAS, the above RTI application dated 12.03.2019 was received on the same date, however, on not getting any response from the PIO, Nagaland Rural Bank, Head Office, Kohima to his RTI application dated 12.03.2019, the applicant had, vide letter dated 19.07.2019 submitted a first appeal to the FAA, Nagaland Rural Bank, Kohima against the action/ inaction of the PIO on his RTI application dated 12.03.2019.

AND WHEREAS, on not getting any response from the FAA, Nagaland Rural Bank to his first appeal dated 19.07.2019, the applicant (now appellant) had, vide letter dated 22.10.2019 preferred a second appeal before the Commission.

AND WHEREAS, on receipt of the second appeal dated 22.10.2019, since the first appeal was not heard, the Commission had, vide letter of even No. dated 27.11.2019 directed the First Appellate Authority, Nagaland Rural Bank, Nagaland, Kohima to hear the first appeal in the presence of both the parties i.e., the applicant (now appellant) and the PIO concerned and pass decision within sixty (30) days from the date of receipt of the directive. Thereafter, the hearing of the first appeal, the decision on the first appeal be submitted to the applicant (now appellant) with a copy to the Commission.

AND WHEREAS, in compliance to the directive of the Commission dated 27.11.2019, the Chairman & FAA, Nagaland Rural Bank, Head Office, Kohima had, vide letter No.NRB/37/HO/84/911 dated 02.12.2019 submitted that the PIO, Nagaland Rural Bank, Kohima had vide letter No.NRB/36/HO/84/1175 dated 15.03.2019 replied to the RTI application advising the applicant to refer to the Order dated 07.02.2019 wherein the word "dismissal" was

not spelled anywhere, and in the absence of such "dismissal" order in the records, his request could not be furnished. He stated that the reply was dispatched to his given address under registered post No.RL A RE480466656IN dated 18.03.2019. Further, he also stated that on receipt of the first appeal dated 19.07.2019, a reply was given vide letter No.NRB/37/HO/17/396 dated 01.08.2019 wherein copies of Enquiry-cum-Findings report dated 03.09.2018 was furnished to the applicant through speed post No.EE497807836IN dated 02.08.2019. Photo copies of the above letters alongwith Enquiry-cum-Finding Report were found enclosed.

AND WHEREAS, the Commission had observed that since whatever information sought by the applicant (now appellant) as per his RTI application dated 12.03.2019 had already been furnished, there seems no further action required.

NOW THEREFORE, it is notified to all the parties that this appeal case is hereby declared as closed:-


