WHEREAS, the Commission had on 27.10.2022 received a Second Appeal dated 27/10/2022 from Shri. Roka Swu, M.No. 9366071145, and Shri. Cheno, M.No. 872999303, against non-response of the FAA, NSDMA, Nagaland to their First Appeal dated 12/10/2022 which was submitted against the "incomplete and fabricated information" furnished by the PIO to their RTI application dated NIL.

AND WHEREAS, the applicants had submitted an RTI application dated *NIL* along with application fee of *Rs. 10/- only* to the PIO, Nagaland State Disaster Management Authority, Nagaland requesting to furnish the following information *under the implementation of the State Disaster Mitigation Fund 2021-2022, Central Ministry sanctioned amount of Rs. 8.20 crores and State Disaster Response Fund 2021-2022, Central Ministry Sanctioned amount of Rs. 32.80 crores.*

- 1. Sanctioned order fund released by the central ministry under SDMF and SDRF 2021-2022.
- 2. Utilization Certificate of SDMF and SDRF.
- 3. Abstract name details of all the beneficiaries along with the details of Project and amount released to beneficiaries of all the districts.
- 4. Provide details on the Mode of Payment whether banking or cash disbrusment.
- 5. All other related documents under SDMF and SDRF 2021-2022

AND WHEREAS, on receipt of the RTI application on 05/07/2022, Shri. Lhouchalie Viya, IAS, Secretary & PIO, NSDMA, Home Department, Nagaland had, vide letter No.NSDMA/RTI/274/2019(Pt)/6583 dated 09/08/2022 furnished the information to the applicants as below:-

AND WHEREAS, on receipt of the above reply from the PIO, the applicant had preferred/submitted the First Appeal dated 12.09.2022 to the Appellate Authority, NSDMA stating that the provided information was fabricated which leads to incomplete documents, with no proper details record of where and how the fund has been implemented and monitored. Further there were repeated names typed in the beneficiary list without any enclosed identification authority, and that the department had only highlighted the work in the paper without any evidence to support the development.

AND WHEREAS, on receipt of the First Appeal dated 12/09/2022 by the public authority on 13/09/2022, since there was no action or response from the FAA to their First Appeal, the applicants (now appellants) had submitted second appeal dated 27/10/2022 to the Commission.

AND WHEREAS, since there was no action or response of the FAA even after the expiry of 45 (forty five) days to their First Appeal which was submitted against the non-satisfaction of the information provided by the PIO, the Commission has decided to hear the above mentioned Second Appeal by giving opportunity of being heard to all the parties on 19th January, 2023 (Thursday) at 11:30 A.M in the Hearing Room of the Nagaland Information Commission, Agri-Farm Colony, Lane-6, H/No. AFC/578, Nagaland, Kohima.
